The meeting was called to order at 10:05 AM

**Administrative**

A brief discussion was held on a letter that was submitted to the Selectmen from the Energy Committee asking them to support a veto of HB 365. Art explained that he is not in favor of signing the letter. Cheryl made a motion for the Selectmen to not support or sign the letter submitted by the Energy Committee to Governor Sununu. Art seconded the motion. All in favor by roll call, motion carried.

A general discussion was held on the disposal of solar panels at the end of their life.

Assessor Mandy Irving joined the meeting to discuss the solar panel assessment on the Quaker Church.

Mandy explained that this is not residential solar, she valued as a commercial entity. When Oxbow Solar LLC received the tax bill, she was upset and asked Mandy to submit documentation she used to make the determination of the value. Mandy explained why she felt that this is a commercial entity, Oxbow Solar LLC is selling the electricity generated to others. The Selectmen agree that this is not a residential use. Mandy explained that Oxbow Solar LLC has submitted an alternate valuation of \$35,000. Mandy stated that she has no problem accepting the valuation submitted. George made a motion to change the assessment to \$35,000. Cheryl seconded the motion. All in favor by roll call, motion carried.

Art made a motion to enter into a non-public session under RSA-91-A: 3 II (c) to discuss a personnel matter at 10:55AM. Cheryl seconded the motion. All in favor by roll call, motion carried.

Art made a motion to exit the non-public session at 12:01 AM and to permanently seal the minutes do to the personnel matter discussed. Cheryl seconded the motion. All in favor by roll call, motion carried.
