The proposals were comparable in scope, price and timing. Both firms have very good reputations and experience working with communities. The sample plan submitted by EMC contained more detail than the FORECO plan. Discussion included that we might need an abstract or executive summary if we choose EMC and our plan contains the level of detail that is in their sample report, and also that we could potentially choose the other company for a future project and later compare experiences and results. Bob Steenson moved that the commission select Ecosystem Management Company to prepare a land management plan for the Kimball/Fife Conservation Areas and authorize the chair to execute an agreement for the work.
