## Energy Committee Zoom Meeting Minutes August 3, 2020

- 1. Chair Ruth Heath started the meeting at 7:30. The minutes from the July 7 meeting were reviewed and approved unanimously.
- <u>2. ButtonUp</u> last minute details were reviewed. There are 28 possible attendees for the Zoom meeting. Andy Duncan has set up the Zoom meeting, and Ted Stiles will help. Claudia will check with Ken about last night's Selectmen's decision and ask if we should inform the police department about possible increased foot traffic in the center for our event.
