Good Afternoon,

During one of my building permitting processes I came across an inconsistency between our zoning rules and the State on NH rules regarding setback from public major bodies of water (over 10 acres or on state list). Ours says 200 ft from Merrimack river and the state requires a shore land protection application for anything 250 ft from major bodies of water.
