Board of Adjustment Notice of Meeting 2 December

Thank you for representing me at the Hearing on property of the Ginger Laplante Revocable Trust at 137 Old Tilton Road to ask if the request about “simple primitive campsites” to be located there should or should not be granted.

We are abutters but not neighbors and have no reason to oppose the “simple primitive campsites” because their project would not affect us. Our address on Orchard Road has our farmland and the Orchard extending between us.

At your suggestion I called Ginger Laplante’s stepdaughter, Leeanne Mackey now living with Ginger and looking after her. Leanne Mackey is putting this project together. Leanne said the campsites are planned primarily for horse riders as her dad had there years ago when she was a child, but they would be for others also.

Some questions about her plans occur to me. You might want to ask about these.

Parking: Would there be horse trailers parked in a parking lot on Old Tilton Road? RV’s, trucks, etc?

Horses: Where would the horses be tied up, by the campsites, or in the riding ring or a paddock?

Campsites: “ Fire circles:” Would she provide firewood for the twelve fire circles she proposes? In a dry season like this when no out door fires are allowed, she would provide camp stoves.

Sanitation: Would she provide toilets and showers? Would horse “road apples” at the property and passing roadway be picked up?

Trash: Would there be trash barrels to collect trash and take to “da Dump?”
