<p>ARTICLE 02 OPERATING BUDGET</p> <p>Shall the School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set for on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purpose set forth therein, totaling twenty-eight million, nine hundred twenty nine thousand, seven hundred seventy five dollars (\$28,929,775)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be twenty eight million, eight hundred twenty three thousand, and two hundred ninety two dollars (\$28,823,292), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Shaker Regional School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.</p>	<p>YES <input type="radio"/></p> <p>NO <input type="radio"/></p>
<p>ARTICLE 03 ADDITION TO SCHOOL FACILITIES & GROUNDS EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND</p> <p>Shall the School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to be added to the School Facilities & Grounds Expendable Trust Fund which was established at the March 21, 1997 Annual District Meeting. This sum to come from June 30, 2024 unassigned fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. (The School Board recommends passing this article.) <p>ARTICLE 04 ADDITION TO TECHNOLOGY EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND</p> <p>Shall the School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to be added to the Technology Expendable Trust Fund which was established at the March 5, 2010 Annual District Meeting. This sum to come from June 30, 2024 unassigned fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. (The School Board recommends passing this article.) <p>ARTICLE 05 ESTABLISH A FOOD SERVICE EQUIPMENT EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND</p> <p>Shall the School District vote to establish a Food Service Equipment Expendable Trust Fund per RSA 198:20-c, V for the purpose of replacing Food Service Equipment as needed, and to raise and appropriate twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to be placed in the fund. This sum to come from June 30, 2024 unassigned fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. And further, to name the school board as agents to expend from the fund. (The School Board recommends passing this article.)
